

Live the History San Pasqual Valley

FROM GENERAL KEARNEY TOH-GENERAL

General Stephen Watts Kearney charged down these hills towards the Californios during the battle of San Pasqual. Outnumbered and exhausted, General Kearney took on the Californios after the longest march in U.S. Military history. Most of the horses had died during the march and Kearney and his men charged on mules. With damp gun powder, the Americans faced combatants armed with lances and reatas. Whether he won the battle or lost is still debated, but the story of San Pasqual lives on.

Bandy Canyon, where Rancho Santa Maria is located, started California's very own H.G. Fenton. Fenton's destitute mother worked for the Bandy Ranch and when they required more help she convinced her employers that her seven year old son could earn his keep, so they brought him over from the orphanage that he had been placed in to work the ranch.



After years of working at Bandy Canyon, 28 year old Fenton began to purchase large portions of the property in 1900. Eventually Fenton went on to establish a contracting company which has flourished and diversified into many companies still thriving in San Diego today.
